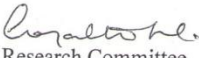

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REPORT ON MINOR RESEARCH PROJECT

2021-2022

The Minor Research Project titled **“Child Labour in Bengaluru South- The Major Challenge in the Implementation of Right to Education Act, 2009”** is successfully completed and submitted to the Research Committee of B. M. S College of Law. The Report consists of Five Chapters. The First Chapter is an Introduction to the research comprising of Statement of the Research Problem, Objectives of the Research, Research Questions, Significance of the Research, Scope and Limitation of the Study, Research Methodology, Sources and Collection of Data, Funding Pattern and Scheme of the Study. The Second Chapter is titled as “Legislative and Policy Framework governing Child Labour and Education”. The Investigator has delved into Constitutional Safeguards, policy framework, judicial precedents and other legislations on Child Labour and Education. The Third Chapter is “Critical Evaluation of Legislative Safeguards relating to Child Labour and Education”. The salient provisions of Child Labour (Prohibition and Regulation) Act, 1986, Child Labour (Prohibition and Regulation) Amendment Act, 2016, Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act, 2015 and Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 are discussed and critically evaluated to understand how child labour is the major obstacle to right to education. The Fourth Chapter, “Relationship between rise in Child Labour and increasing Out of School Children” is empirical in nature. Interview with Member of Child Welfare Committee, Labour Inspector, Member of Non-Governmental Organization and Government School Teacher was conducted in online mode owing to the ongoing Covid-19 pandemic. Chapter V includes Conclusion, Findings and Suggestions.

The Principal Investigator of the Minor Research Project was Dr. Roopa S, Assistant Professor, B.M.S College of Law. Dwithi C Acharya, IX Semester BA. LL. B and Chandani G S,



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VII Semester B.Com. LL. B were Research Assistants. It was presented before the external members of the Research Committee, Prof. (Dr.) Ramesh, National Law School of India University and Prof. (Dr.) C S Patil, Karnataka State Law University and suggestions made by them were incorporated.
