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Report on "Law of Taxation"

Sri Sagar Nagaraj, Advocate & Tax Consultant, Bengaluru and Alumnus of BMS College of Law delivered Guest Lecture on "Law of Taxation" from 3rd to 7th September, 2018. He explained the provisions of taxation laws briefly. The Income tax Act, 1961 provides a mechanism for computing the tax relating to the income of an assessee pertaining to an assessment year. Such computation is made after allowing various deductions, exemptions and rebates to the assessee and is called assessment. He explained the meaning of assessee, assessment year and the residential status of an assessee. He also gave a brief overview of the Wealth Tax Act. On whom the wealth tax can be levied was also highlighted. There are two kinds of tax- direct and indirect. Indian taxation system has undergone tremendous reforms during the last decade. The direct taxes are income tax, wealth tax and corporate tax. The indirect taxes are sales tax, central sales tax, excise duty, customs duty and service tax. It was a very interesting and brainstorming session. It was well attended by staff and students.

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Report on "Intellectual Property Rights"

On 03/04/2018 Guest Lecture was delivered by Sri. Sanjay Sethia, on the topic "Intellectual Property Rights." He gave an overview of Intellectual property laws. Intellectual property rights are the rights given to persons over the creations of their minds. He said they are ideas, inventions and creative expressions based on which there is public willingness to bestow the status of property. It refers to creations such as literary works, artistic works, inventions, designs, symbols, commercial names and images. It covers copyrights, patents, trademarks, trade secrets, geographical indications and industrial designs. He explained the meaning of the above through the legislative provisions. The procedure for filing, what is registrable, what is not registrable, scope, duration and the rights available was exhaustively discussed. He also highlighted the judicial response in India on IPR. He also briefly discussed the international treaties relating to Intellectual Property Rights. It was well attended by staff and students.

Report on "Competition Law and Jio Case"



A guest lecture was delivered by Ms. Kavitha Jithani, Advocate, Samvad Partners and Alumnus of BMS College of law on 19/08/2017 on the topic "Competition Law and Jio Case." She explained the facts of the case, legal issues involved and the consequences of the judgment. The telecom sector in India has witnessed intense competition over the past decade. The arrival of Reliance Jio and the Vodafone- Idea merger re-inforce the steep competition that exists in this sector - which forces the market players to continuously enhance their performance and gain an edge over their competitors. In Bharti Airtel v. Reliance Jio, where the CCI held that Reliance Jio was not in a dominant position in the market and was not indulging in predatory pricing. Bharti Airtel contended that Reliance Jio was engaging in predatory pricing through various offers. The CCI went on to note that according to market data,

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Reliance Jio does not have a market share of more than 7% and that there exists sufficient choice to customers. The other legal issue was whether Jio is considered to be in a dominant position in the telecom market as of today. But the CCI held that mere market share does not determine the dominant position. Hence according to her this is one of the landmark judgments that students of competition law should thoroughly understand. It was a very interesting session with student interaction. It was well attended by staff and students.

Report on "The Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996"

On 04/03/2017, a Special Lecture was delivered by Sri. H S Dwarkanath, Senior Advocate, High Court of Karnataka on the topic, "The Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996". He gave an overview of the provisions of Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996. Arbitration and conciliation are alternative methods of dispute resolution. It creates a win-win situation wherein parties settle the disputes peacefully and amicably. The procedure to be followed in arbitration and conciliation was elaborately explained. There are two kinds of arbitration namely domestic and international arbitration. The drafting of arbitration agreement, who shall be parties and what shall be the contents was elucidated. He enlightened the audience on appointment of arbitrators. The most essential quality of an arbitrator is impartiality. The arbitral award shall be enforced by the civil court and cannot be challenged before court of law. It was well attended by staff and students.

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The Speaker concluded that the personalised observation with impersonal judgement will ensure divinity in the justice delivery system.

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Report on "Role of Forensic Science in Delivering Justice"

On 17/2/2017, Guest Lecture was delivered by Dr. C V Mohan, Managing Director, Samleen Bio Engineering Pvt. Ltd., on the topic, "Role of Forensic Science in Delivering Justice". He explained the meaning of forensic science and the various concepts involved in it. The main objective of forensic science is to provide direction to those conducting criminal investigation and to provide correct information. He gave an overview of legal provisions supporting forensic analysis of criminal investigation. He also highlighted how there is restricted application of forensic evidence in Indian Judiciary. Many people are misguided about investigation due to the way it is shown in movies and web series. Starting from the commission of crime to conviction, it requires a lot of time. Technology plays a very important role in forensic science. He explained in detail the procedure adopted for collection of evidence. He discussed provisions of Indian Constitution, Indian Evidence Act and CrPC along with important case laws. He also cited reasons such as improper collection, preservation as to why court does not readily accept forensic evidence. It was truly an intriguing session with wonderful participation by students and staff.

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REPORT ON THE GUEST LECTURE BY CV SUDHINDRA ON THE TOPIC PROSECUTION AND SANCTION TO PROSECUTE

.In India, Crimes have diversified since the development of society to eliminate these crimes

The parliament has enacted many laws ,but due to various problems in the society the laws are enabling to bring satisfactory results. With the view to enlighten lawyers about the general principles of criminal law C.V SUDHINDRA, practising senior advocate Hon'ble high court of Karnataka. Presented a lecture on "PROSECUTION AND SANCTION TO PROSECUTE". On 22nd September 2016 in the BMS college of law. The aim of this lecture was to educate the students of law ON THE PROCEDURAL ASPECT OF CRIME.

He started his lecture by quoting the words of Albert Einstein "*The world as we have created it is a process of our thinking. It cannot be changed without changing our thinking.*" He further enlightened about general principle of criminal law with the help of present cases, He even touched upon **THE POCSO ACT** which was enacted with a view to curb mischief committed by the intruder against the children.

He further stated the technical aspects of criminal procedure practised before the courts, he even cited Guddikattinarasimharaowhere Hon'bleSupreme Court held that accused is presumed to be innocent until proven guilty. He even highlighted Gurubakshsinghsibia case in which justice Krishna iyaerexplained the importance of anticipatory bail and considering right to bail of the accused as part of article 21 of Indian constitution.

He explained the certain provision of CrPC, majorly concentrated on Sec.161 and 162 of CrPC which is read with 145 of evidence act.

To conclude the lecture it is fair to say the human greed and his malafide intentions have led us to a society which is based on materialist benefits than of human values which is why laws are increasing day by day to adapt with these wrongs committed hence the criminal law plays a vital role in achieving this objective and making our society a better place to live in.

Report on "Right to Privacy as a Fundamental Right"

A Guest Lecture was delivered by Prof. Ravivarma Kumar, Senior Advocate and Alumnus of BMS College of Law on 13/02/2016 on the topic, "Right to Privacy as a Fundamental Right." The Indian Constitution confers on every individual right to life under Article 21 which includes right to privacy as well. He explained the same with the help of decided case laws. In Kharak Singh's case, the court has correctly held that the expression 'life' under Article 21 does not mean mere animal existence. Life and personal liberty are inalienable rights. According to him these are not created by constitution but are inherent rights of every human being. He said the term 'privacy' encompasses within itself preservation of personal intimacies, sanctity of family life, marriage, procreation, home and sexual orientation. The aim of right to privacy is to protect heterogeneity and recognizes plurality and diversity of our culture. He also explained the reasonable restrictions on right to privacy. Informational privacy is the new facet of right to privacy. He explained the positive as well as negative content of right to privacy. It was highly informative and was well attended by staff and students.

Report on "Surrogacy-Socio-legal Concerns in India"

On 12/02/2016 a Special Lecture was delivered by Ms. Sonali Kusum, Ph.D Research Scholar, NLSIU, Bangalore, Ex-Assistant Professor, School of Law, Tata Institute of Social Sciences, Mumbai on the topic, "Surrogacy- Socio-legal Concerns in India." The increasing cases of infertility and the inherent human desire to procreate have led to unprecedented growth in the usage of assisted reproductive technologies around the globe. With the advent of assisted reproductive technologies surrogate parenting has risen sharply in recent years. She explained the meaning of surrogacy, the legal provisions, issues and challenges confronting surrogacy. She expressed her concern over cross-border commercial surrogacy arrangements and the socio-ethical factors involved in the same. Surrogacy has its own share of advantages and disadvantages. She elaborately discussed the ongoing debate as to whether surrogacy enables exercise of procreative rights or undermines reproductive justice. The rights of children born out of surrogacy, the identity crisis faced by them and the parentage are certain challenges. The surrogate mothers are exposed to potential health risk. The controversial provisions under Surrogacy Bill were also discussed. Overall it was a very interesting session and was well received by staff and students.
