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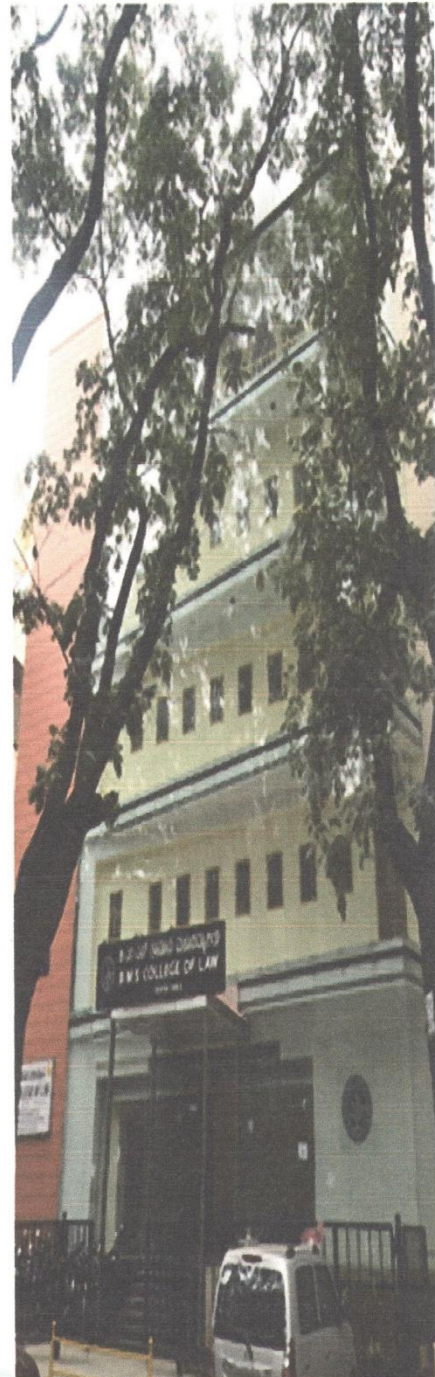

The Trust is named after Late Dharmaprakasha Rajakaryaprasaktha B.M. Sreenivasaiah, whose philanthropy resulted in the establishment of the First Engineering College under the Private Management of the State of Karnataka. BMS Educational Trust now runs the highly reputed institutions, providing education to around 12000 students in areas like Engineering, Law, Science, Commerce, Information Technology and Architecture. The College of Law is recognised by the BCI and is affiliated to Karnataka State Law University (KSLU).

GOAL 1 - STRIVING TO BUILD A STRONG AND SUSTAINABLE INFRASTRUCTURE & INCREASED INTAKE

BMS College of Law has more than five decades' legacy. Presently, the BMS Law College building is situated in the heart of the city at VV Puram. 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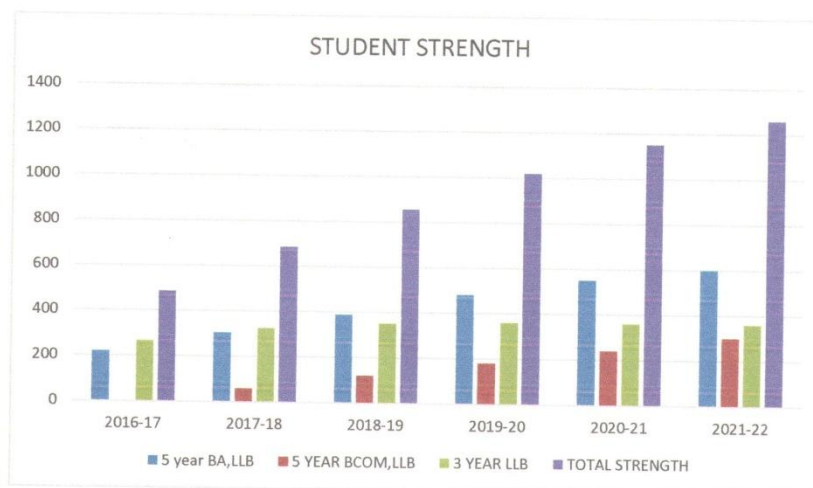

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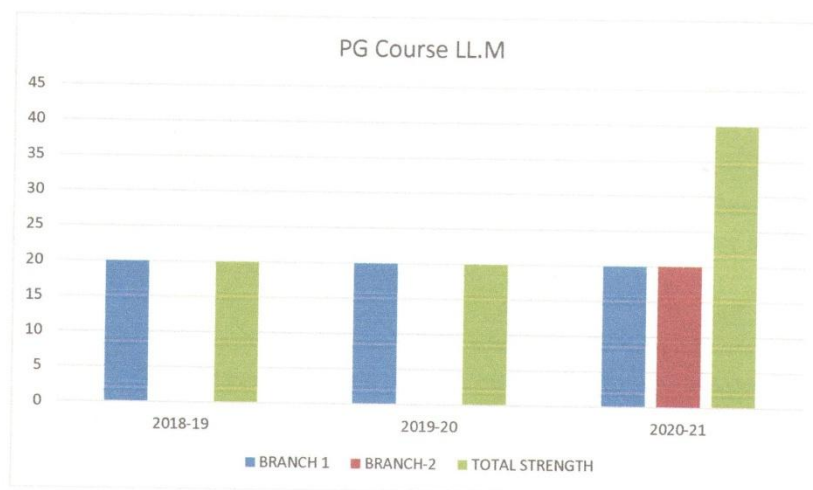

Initiative 1- *Nurture and support a culture where faculty members are continuously engaged in curricular and pedagogical assessment and innovation that equips our students to meet the evolving demands of the legal profession.*

We will build a strong teaching culture that has been the hallmark of BMS institutions since more than five decades. We will induct quality faculty to reinforce the present system and provide faculty members means and methods, encouragement and support structure necessary to foster innovative teaching that meets the educational needs of the students for today and tomorrow. We will continuously educate ourselves on changes in legal education and law practices, engage in national debates on best practices in teaching, provide resources and incentives for excellent teaching and encourage outside evaluation and development of teaching skills.



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Initiative 2- Provide robust environment for research and development.

Just as legal education and law practices are evolving, so too is legal research & development. There are more collaborative efforts taking place, both interdisciplinary and international, new legal research methodologies in play and a proliferation of new outlets for disseminating information. Our ability to capitalize on these changes, enhance our influence and achieve distinction in the future will be enriched by education and skill development in these emerging areas. We will build on existing incentives and support structures to extend the reach and impact of faculty scholarship, in all its forms. Areas of initiation will include: -

- Continued development of faculty research, exchange programs with other law schools and the colleges, internal workshop program;
- Enhanced research mentoring and continued growth of internal development programs devoted to all faculty members;
- Course scheduling that will allow time for intense research and teaching related projects; and
- Increased other research support.

Initiative 3- Improve the coordination of measures designed to promote the awareness and influence of faculty's scholarly work.

The BMS College of Law faculty comprises of talented and diverse teachers, many of whom are part of a recent hiring surge in which junior and mid-level will be in conformity with each other. We will strengthen our efforts to promote broad awareness and recognition of faculty scholarship and related activities as well as help them bring their work to a wide and diverse audience. Areas of initiation will include:

- Broadening faculty's engagement with online research databases, such as the Social Science Research Network (SSRN), which are gaining cachet as research venues for showcasing and auditioning works in progress;



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- Enhancing systematic coordination with the college's communications department for promotion of faculty publications, policy work and areas of expertise;
- Using the capacity of the present and new building to foster greater awareness of faculty knowledge through the strategic use of hosted regional and national debates;
- Increasing, where possible, the level support of faculty presentations at influential conferences that will facilitate networking with leaders in the field and provide a forum for one's scholarly work; and
- Enhancing the visibility and influence of faculty in a wide variety of recognized outlets, from traditional journals, magazines to electronic media.

Initiative 4- *Building a strong and diverse body of Student Community by establishing of Alumni base. Leverage to strengthen the alumni community's engagement with the College and the formation of alumni identity.*

BMS college alumni generally graduates with strong positive feelings about their peers. Their present participation reflects this reality while also suggesting there are significant opportunities for greater alumni engagement. All of our alumni have experienced the college as a space-limited commuter venue that offers little ability to connect with their alma- mater because of its physical identity. The new campus and building, for students and the community, will give us an opportunity to change the way we reach out to our alumni and use the facility to inform alumni identity. The College will develop a comprehensive plan for alumni engagement. We envision an expansion of opportunities for alumni to participate working with students as adjuncts and the like. We will also develop a plan for increasing alumni networks, where we have a significant alumni presence, and in substantive areas of practice, through networks, where there is considerable alumni interest.



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Initiative 5 - Enrich degree with new joint programmes & by offering PG Diploma Course

The college will strengthen and build upon curriculum to prepare students to effectively engage in the complex realities of modern practice. It will develop experiential opportunities and employ innovative pedagogy to blend the teaching of doctrine with the development of practice-related competencies and professional judgment. It will also explore and seize upon new opportunities to grow in programs. It will coordinate and leverage the strengths of existing experiential learning opportunities, including clinics, and simulated law practice experiences to provide all students with the opportunity to develop fundamental lawyer skills in meaningful contexts. By increasing the availability of experiential learning opportunities for our students, it not only will enhance learning outcomes, but we also will position the college to explore and adopt expanded transition to practice options in the upper level curriculum characterized by immersion in practice settings, as well as a stronger partnership with the practicing bar. Our broader, innovative curriculum also will enable us to consider requiring a clinical or other experiential learning opportunity for every student and prepare students for success as highly knowledgeable, competent and ethical legal professionals. What will deserve more attention is that most of the students do not feel confident to make presentations and speeches. Realizing the importance of these skills in the modern day life, the college will make communication and managing skills as part of the curriculum studies. Communication skills will help the students to express feelings, thoughts and expressions and thus they will get across the point successfully to the listener. The students will be taught as how to give undivided attention to a person with whom a conversation is taking place. Students will be infused with healthy feeling of competition and curiosity. This would develop communication, confidence and etiquette of speaking.
